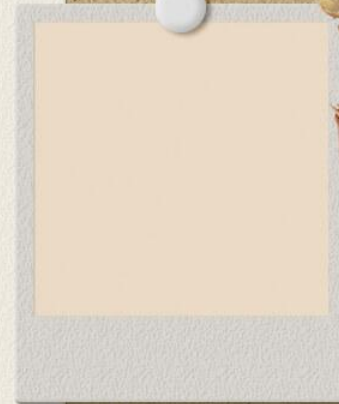
✘ Inclusive Environment

- Athletics is open to all - clearance forms required



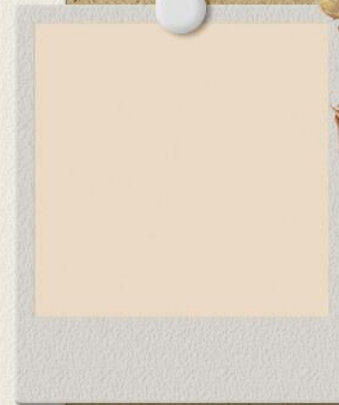

What Can Parents Do?

- ✦ Be Involved
 - ✦ Follow weekly email updates
 - ✦ Encourage your student to be involved
 - ✦ Attend school events
 - ✦ Contact teachers when you have questions regarding class
 - Contact administrators when you have questions regarding the site
 - Contact administrators after you have contacted other staff, if you need additional information or support
- ✦ Athletics Need Support
 - ✦ District provides budget that does not meet the transportation needs
 - ✦ District provides supply budget
 - ✦ District pays coach stipends
 - ✦ Other items fall on site and specific programs (officials bills, additional gear, transportation)



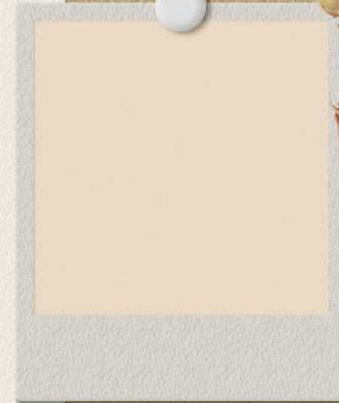
What Can Parents Do?

- ✘ SSC meets once a month, October through May - we are in need of two parent participants - look for nomination form on the Sunday evening message (you can self nominate)



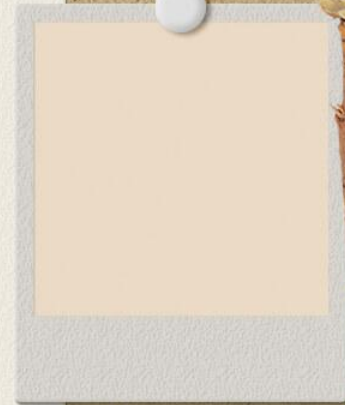

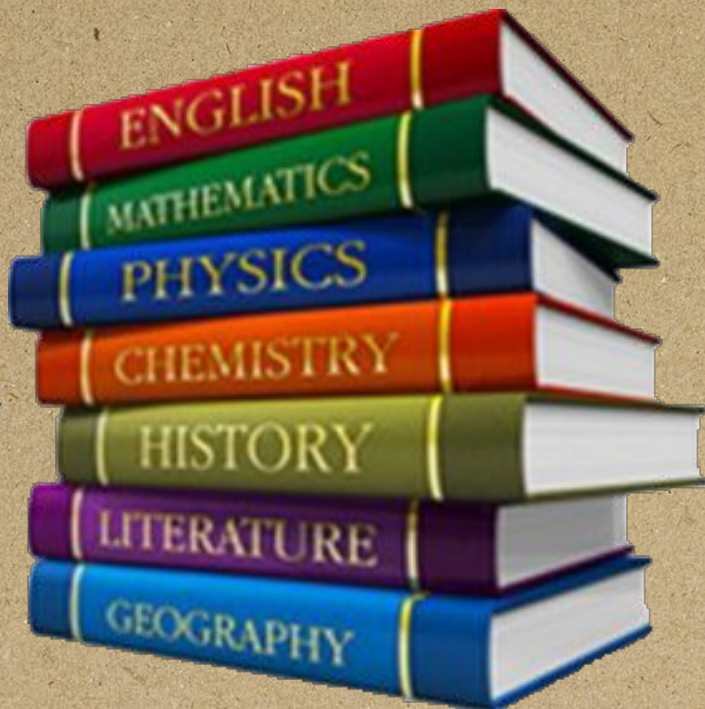

- ✘ Full WASC Year - look for opportunities to volunteer in late October to early November



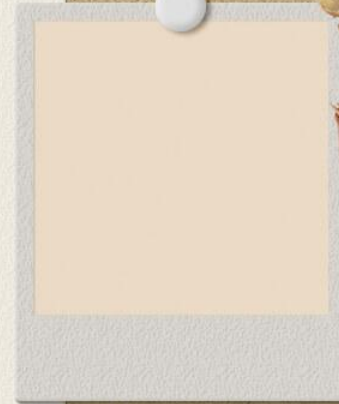

Academic Information

A-G are the courses that students complete to become eligible for acceptance into the UC and CSU systems - these are above and beyond the High School graduation requirements (in some cases)

- ✘ All students are scheduled to be able to complete A-G eligibility - evidenced by 95.8% of Class of 2022 completion rate
- ✘ Must have “C” or better to count towards A-G status - “D” can count towards High School graduation status
- ✘ For more specifics on these requirements, please join us at College Night on October 6, 2022 - 5:30 pm to 6:30 pm - all grade level families are welcome

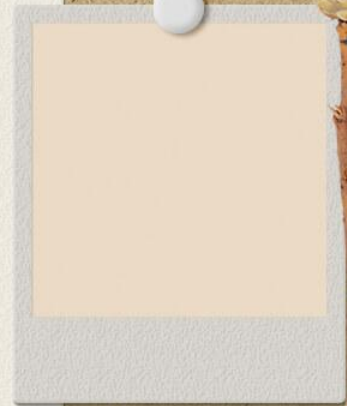


Athletics Information

All students are eligible to attend off season workouts for any team

To attend in-season practices, all students must complete the clearance packet:
